Susan M. Gibbons is a fine artist who resides and works in the Denver Metro area. Her work has been exhibited in solo and group exhibitions throughout Denver and Aurora but has exhibited nationally as well. Susan's work has been included in publications such as Fusion IV, Christianity and the Arts, Mars Hill Review, and First Fruits – A Compilation of Art.

Susan works with the ancient media of encaustic (pigmented bee's wax) as well as with acrylic, graphite, and ink. Her inspiration comes from the Abstract Expressionists, times of quiet contemplation and prayer, poetry, and the world around her.
